- ☆ Registration and Clinic Day – 7 March 2016 @ 4.00pm
Please register at the Clubrooms from 4.00pm

- ☆ Clinic will commence at 4.15pm for all Gr 3/4 & Gr 5/6 players. This clinic will be run by accredited Kingston Blues Coaches and current State League Players.

- ☆ 1st roster match will commence on Monday, 21 March.

- ☆ Roster matches games will commence at the following times each week
 - Grades 3/4 4.15pm
 - Grades 5/6 5.00pm

- ☆ Registration fee for this roster is \$70.00 - \$40.00 for Club players.

- ☆ **Each team must have a coach, an umpire and provide their own ball and bibs**

- ☆ Team registrations are to be forwarded secretary@kna.net.au on or before **Friday, 4 March 2016**.

- ☆ All players **MUST** complete a registration form **BEFORE** they can participate in the roster. There can be no exceptions or allowances made in this regard as it is an Insurance and Liability issue.

Working with Vulnerable People Registration A Tasmanian Working with Vulnerable People Registration (WWVP Registration) card is a compulsory criminal

history check for everybody who works or volunteers with children under the age of 18 years.

It was established by the Registration to Work with Vulnerable People Act 2013 (the Act) and is administered by the Department of Justice.

The Act applies to anyone involved in child-related work in Tasmania. It does not matter whether the work is paid or unpaid, supervised or unsupervised.

***Please note: KNA, as an Association, is bound by this legislation and all coaches of junior teams must have a registration in place by 1 April 2015.**

Coaches will be required to present proof of registration to the Rosters Convenor.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL TEAMS

Coaches and umpires should ensure that all games are to be played with good sportsmanship. No 'sledging' from players or spectators will be permitted.

KNA strongly advises all coaches of teams, playing in KNA rosters, to have an official membership of the Tasmanian Netball Associations. The cost is \$26.00. This will ensure that coaches have sports insurance and a public liability component, in the event of an incident/accident for children who are in their care, whilst at netball. For more details please contact us.

Uniforms

- All teams must wear correct uniform with the same coloured tops, netball skirt or sports shorts. Sports shoes must be worn.
- Track pants will only be permitted if the weather is extremely cold.
- Players must be in the correct uniform to play in the finals.

Cancellation of Games

- Teams must provide KNA with contact details of their coach/team manager so important roster information and cancellations can be relayed without delay.
- KNA Rosters Convenor will also notify schools, if possible, before 2.30 when games are cancelled.
- Cancellations will also be posted to the KNA Facebook page.
- Notification of a forfeit is the responsibility of the forfeiting team. Please let Roster Convenor know early as possible.

Jewellery

NO JEWELLERY IS PERMITTED TO BE WORN.

- This includes ear rings, nose rings, bracelets, necklaces and hair combs.
- Umpires will ask players to remove their jewellery before the game commences. Players who refuse to remove jewellery will not be permitted to play.
- **NOTE:** Jewellery cannot be covered with tape.

This is an AANA regulation and KNA is bound to abide by this rule to ensure that insurance cover for players is not void.

Fingernails

Fingernails **must be** cut short. Taping is not permitted.

Games

Games will be centrally timed

4 x 12 minute quarters for the Grade 5/6 and High School Roster

4 x 10 minute quarters for the 3 / 4 roster or NETTA rules roster.

Score Sheets

The winning team is responsible for taking the score sheet to the KNA Clubrooms after each game.
