Covid-19 Policy

Updated 13 October 2020

To Kingborough Netball Association (KNA) Members, Families and Visitors,

As we continue to navigate a world that now includes Covid-19, players, and attendees at the KNA Venue are asked to abide by Netball Tasmania's 'Return to Netball' Policy which was updated on 21 September 2020.

The KNA Covid-19 Policy in conjunction with Netball Tasmania's 'Return to Play' is as follows:

- All attendees, participating and non-participating, must not attend training, matches or the venue if they are unwell.
- KNA has a two (2) spectators per player policy. This includes BOTH outdoor and indoor courts. It does NOT include players, coach, assistant coach, team manager or umpire for each team, or KNA Officials.
- The KNA Clubrooms has a maximum people count of 47 and is divided as follows:
 - ❖ KNA Foyer – 15
 - ❖ KNA Meeting Room – 24
 - ❖ KNA Canteen – 4
 - ❖ KNA Female Toilets – 3
 - ❖ KNA Male Toilet - 1
- Social distancing standards of 1.5m should be maintained, except where individuals share the same household. This includes team benches and score benches.
- Attendees should arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the commencement of a game and proceed directly to the court to allow for 10 minutes warm up – *this does not apply for the KNA Carnival*.
- Attendees should depart the court no later than 10 minutes after the game is over. *This does not apply for the KNA Carnival*.
- For KNA Carnival only - Teams should vacate indoors courts and move to the outdoor court areas unless their next rostered game is inside. All teams who have a rostered bye should move to the outdoor courts area.
- On arrival attendees should use the stand-alone hand sanitiser stations before proceeding to the courts.
- Match balls AND goal post covers are to be sanitised prior to the commencement of matches, and again at the conclusion. Sanitising equipment will be provided for each court.
- Scorers are asked to bring their own pen.
- Players are asked to use hand sanitiser between games.
- No sharing of drink bottles/towels should occur, and no food/snacks should be shared, unless individually packaged.
- KNA encourages all attendees to download the COVID Safe app.
- KNA will have cleaning protocols in place throughout the Venue.
- Upon departure attendees should use the stand-alone hand sanitiser stations.

We extend our sincere thanks to the netball community for your patience and understanding during this unprecedented Covid-19 situation.
